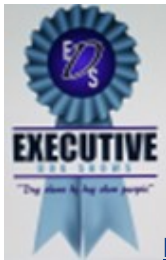

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- The show building will be open to exhibitors Monday 4:00 to 11:00 PM.
- The show building will be open 6:00 AM to 11:00 PM Tuesday through Saturday, and 6:00 AM to 10:00 AM Sunday. The building must be vacated by Sunday at 10:00 AM.
- All doors will be locked at 11:00 PM each night. For dogs left in the building, all crates must be marked with responsible parties' contact info. Crate tags will be available from Reserved Grooming Chairs.
- **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR BEVERAGE ALLOWED** in the SageNet Center. There will be a concession stand available with a variety of foods, including salads and gluten free options.
- **EVERYONE is REQUIRED** to promptly clean up after their dogs. Failure to do so will be grounds for an event hearing in accordance with AKC's Dealing with Misconduct Regulations.
- All ex-pens must have plastic underneath and up the sides at least 12 inches.
- Generator use is not permitted on the Expo Square grounds.
- Smoking is prohibited in all Expo Square facilities.
- Anyone using electricity in grooming or vendor spaces is responsible for bringing their own grounded UL listed extension cords and the means to secure them. All power in space must be turned off before leaving each day.
- Gaffers tape must be used to secure anything to the floor. No duct tape.
- Nothing may be affixed to the pillars or walls.
- Stickers may not be placed on floor, wall, or pillars or distributed as a promotional item.
- You have a responsibility to conduct yourselves in a manner that presents the sport of dogs and the Collie breed in the very best light. Each and every time you appear in public with your dogs you have the opportunity to make a positive and lasting impression.

CCA POLICY

- CCA limits unentered dogs to no more than three dogs per grooming space/booking reservation (per reservation - not per grooming space).
- Dogs under 6 months of age are not allowed.

EXHIBITOR MOVE-IN

- Exhibitor move-in will start Monday, March 30 at 4:00 PM or when grooming area setup has been completed by the show committee.
- Vehicles will be permitted in the building if space allows. Before entering the building, exhibitors with vehicles must follow instructions from the Show Committee personnel managing move-in.
- To expedite the unloading process, after unloading your equipment and placing it in your grooming space you **MUST** immediately remove your vehicle from the building before setting up your grooming space.

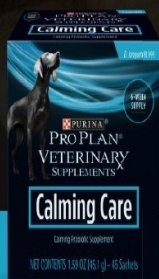
