CONTEST FOR BEST DECORATED GROOMING SPACE, AND PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD

The grooming space decorating competition is a fun way to help bring the energy and enthusiasm of past Nationals back to Visiting Hours. We're excited to offer the competition again in 2026. There will be a PEOPLE'S CHOICE/WINNER'S AWARD in which the winner gets a free grooming space at the 2026 National, a beautiful rosette AND they get to choose where within the ASSA the funds raised are donated. JUDGES EDUCATION SEMINAR & WORKSHOP

The Judges Education Seminar and Workshop will be Thursday, April 2, 2026 at time TBA. The workshop will include classroom time to view a slide presentation, followed by hands-on activities. The workshop is open to Sheltie breeders who are planning to submit an application to AKC within a year or so, and to judges who are already approved for other breeds. Meeting room will be announced at a later date. Attendance will be limited. The cost is \$35 and includes video, instructional pamphlets, and "hands on" experience. Ringside mentoring will be available Thursday, April 2, 2026 and Friday, April 3, 2026 for those enrolled in the workshop. JUNIOR HANDLING CLINIC

All Junior Handlers ages 9 through 18 are welcome and encouraged to participate in the annual handling clinic on **Friday evening, April 3, 2026**. Professional handlers and breeders will be on hand to guide you through the basics and the fine points to help you show your dog to the best of your ability. Please see the schedule below for details:

- One hour after conformation judging, all handlers (ages 9 - 18, novice, intermediate, and open levels) will gather in the main ring. Junior aged handlers (ages 9 - 11) will work together as one group while intermediate and open aged juniors (ages 12 - 18) will work as a separate group. Both groups will work on handling skills for one hour.
- After handling practice, we'll gather again as a whole group to enjoy a pizza party and "mentor summit." You and your mentors can share your mentoring experiences. If someone mentors you, tell us what helps and why. If you mentor somebody else, let us know why you mentor and specifically what you're doing to help others.

Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

Invitational Shelties Spectacular Showcase

This is an invitational event to showcase the Top 20 Breed Conformation dogs, Top 5 Junior Handlers, and Top Owner-Handler based on 2025 year-end rankings. We also welcome all prior Best of Breed winners to be showcased. The event will be held Tuesday evening, March 31st, in the main conformation ring. Only the Top 20 dogs will be judged prior in the day with the evening being a showcase of all invitees. Entry Fee is \$25 to cover the cost of the rosette, and any additional can be purchase for \$25 each. All ribbons **MUST** be picked up at the show - they will not be mailed. All participants need to write a 75 word or less bio to be included in a program that will be available for purchase. Attendance is free and we encourage the audience to dress up!

American Shetland Sheepdog Association Best All Around Sheltie Competition

*To be eligible for this award, dogs must compete in at least **FOUR OF FIVE** events

*One bonus point is awarded to dogs that compete in all five events

*The dog with the highest cumulative score will be awarded as the Best All Around Sheltie

*Runner-Up Best All Around Sheltie will be awarded to the dog receiving the second highest cumulative score

*Advance registration is required.

To register, complete the online form on the National website. Email karakolster@gmail.com with questions.

*Dogs receiving qualifying scores in performance events will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as appropriate for their class, but do not receive the participation point as well. The participation point in performance events is awarded if the dog competes but does not qualify in the event.

*Dogs competing in multiple classes at the same event (for example, Standard & JWW agility, Master & Premier agility, Open & Utility obedience) will be awarded points for the highest-level class in which they receive a qualifying score. Dogs will not receive points for qualifying in more than one class in any event.

*Dogs that make a cut or earn placements and awards in breed competition will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as applicable, but do not receive the participation point as well. Dogs who make multiple cuts in a class will receive the same two points as dogs that make one cut.

*Dogs excused from the breed ring will still be awarded a point for participation. Dogs disqualified from the breed ring will not be awarded a point for participation.

*Preferred agility classes are scored equally to the corresponding regular agility class.

*Non-regular obedience classes are scored as the regular class with similar or next lower difficulty level. For example, a Veterans obedience qualifying score is worth two points because Novice exercises are used. A Beginner Novice qualifying score is worth only one point for participation because exercises are less difficult than Novice. A Graduate Novice qualifying score is worth two points because it is similar to Novice and less difficult than Open. A Graduate Open qualifying score is worth three points.

*Herding Instinct evaluation and Farm Dog certificate are not included in this competition and will not be awarded points.

*Partial points will not be awarded

*In the event of a tie, event scores will be used to break the tie. The dog with the highest total score will receive the award. HT & PT qualifiers do not receive a numerical score, so a score of zero will be used in calculating their total score.

*The official catalog markings from the judges' books for each event will be used to determine eligibility, participation, placements, and official scores.

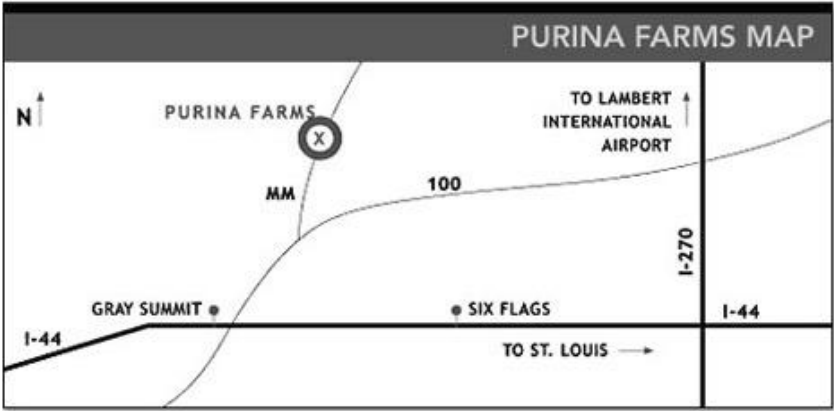
Hotel/Dog Show Guidelines When you sign the show entry form, you automatically agree to the following terms concerning motels. They have been established for the good of all exhibitors and will ensure future use of these facilities.

1. Maximum 4 dogs per room.
2. Dogs left unattended in a guest room **MUST** be in a crate. Plastic sheeting **MUST** be under each crate in the guest room.
3. Hotel guests with dogs in the room need to use the special door hanger provided by the hotel. This hanger will leave instructions to the housekeeping staff. Housekeeping will not enter the room unless the door hanger is present.
4. Housekeeping must be allowed to **INSPECT** a guest room (with dogs) daily. Guests who have special request (e.g. a certain time of the day that room will be vacant) can discuss them with the housekeeping staff upon arrival.
5. Bathing and/or grooming of dogs in or outside the guest room is not allowed. **HOLIDAY INN** has a grooming house on the grounds which will be available for use. The hotel does provide some towels to the grooming area. Grooming is not allowed on any sidewalks.
6. The individual guest will be responsible for any damages to a guest room or any hotel property. This includes, but is not limited to replacement cost of carpeting if odors or stains cannot be removed by traditional cleaning methods. Damage claims must be settled on the spot.
7. Dogs are to be on leash at all times when out of the guest room.
8. The hotel and the show committee will investigate any problem areas that are outlined above. Any guest not following the above guidelines will be asked to check out of the hotel without refund.
9. Guests in violation of any rule or failure to comply may be cause for an official event committee hearing and possible suspension of AKC privileges.
10. Dogs will not be allowed in the following public access areas: lobby, restaurant, lounge.
11. All furniture must remain in the room at all times.
12. Extension cords are not allowed to be plugged into rooms from a vehicle, trailer or camper in the parking lot

This is a SELF-CLEANING SHOW—Both Inside and Out!

This means Exhibitors/Dog Owners are responsible for picking up after their dogs anywhere on the grounds or at any hotel. Non-compliance will be reported. Consequences may include a Bench Show Committee hearing and/ or hotel expulsion. So **PLEASE**, be considerate of others and tidy up after your dog. Never leave your room without pickup baggie in your pocket!

ROUTES TO THE SHOW



From North/East/South: Take I-44 to Gray Summit/Hwy 100 Exit 253. Turn east on Hwy 100. After approximately 1/2 mile, turn left on MM. Entrance to Purina Farms is approximately 1 mile on left.
